The Martin Luther King Jr. holiday on Jan. 18, 2021, is the 26th anniversary of the [day of service](#) that celebrates the Civil Rights leader's life and legacy. Observed each year on the third Monday in January as "a day on, not a day off," MLK Day is the only federal holiday designated as a national day of service to encourage all Americans to volunteer to improve their communities.

12:00 PM - 1:00 PM Grades 3 - 5 Contactless Donation Drop off @ Bradford School



## Please collect and deliver donations on the day of the event:

1. **Non-perishable food** for [Toni's Kitchen](#): Breakfast items (oatmeal, cereal bars, etc.), Pasta, Pasta Sauce (no glass jars, please), Rice, Tuna, Peanut Butter (no glass jars, please), Soup, Nuts, Dried Fruit, Canned Beans
2. **Non-perishable goods** for the [Human Needs Food Pantry](#)  
Healthy items, such as whole grains, low-sugar cereals, and low-sodium canned goods; Pantry staples: tuna, peanut butter, soup, beans, rice, and shelf-stable milk; herbs/spices/olive oil; Non-food essentials, such as diapers/wipes, personal-care items, and cleaning supplies
3. **Supplies** for the [Montclair Animal Shelter](#) Sealed dog and cat food & treats; Canned Cat, Kitten and Dog food; Bleach; Bath towels; Black trash bags; Paper Towels; Dish and hand soap; Non-Clumping Cat litter; Laundry Detergent; Cat toys ; Paper food trays and small paper plates for cat feeding; Newspaper for lining cages; Other cleaning products
